Given America's drug consumption epidemic and the relative ease of global and local narcotics trafficking, it is more important than ever to understand how to infiltrate these networks by utilizing strong and efficient search warrants. This course will teach the student important factors in the warrant acquisition process as well as go over various scenarios and situations common to these types of investigations. Additionally, this class will furnish warrant template examples and cover several components that are sure to support your search warrant application efforts.

Course Introduction – 10 minutes

Instructor introduction.

- 1) Explain the course objective.
 - a) Understand how police management styles can impact narcotics cases.
 - b) Identify the factors that must be present.
 - c) Understanding social media and GPS warrants.
- 2) Encourage attendees to ask questions and share feedback with other attendees.
- 3) Explain that certificates will be emailed after the class and each student will be registered in the Blue to Gold University.
- 4) Go over the three disclaimers:
