Mastering Proactive Policing for Patrol (Instructed by: Sean Meyer)

Being proactive on patrol is about more than just making stops—it's about spotting crime before it happens and handling it safely and legally. This course gives patrol officers the skills and knowledge to confidently interdict criminal activity while keeping themselves and the community safe. You'll learn to recognize the signs of stress and resistance in people you encounter, including freeze, flight, and fight behaviors, plus the subtle cues that come before them. The course covers building reasonable suspicion, conducting roadside interviews, building rapport, and knowing when (and how) to ask for consent. Body camera footage and scenario-based exercises bring these skills to life and give you hands-on practice in real-world situations.

Advanced Criminal Investigations (Instructed by: Zach Miller)

Tough cases call for solid legal skills and a deep understanding of what the courts expect from your work. This course builds on what you already know and takes it up a notch. It helps you tackle advanced search and seizure issues, manage informants, and navigate tricky legal situations with confidence—all while making sure your cases stand up in court. You'll learn about complex legal issues that come up in major cases—like search warrants, managing informants, and working in high-risk environments. The course highlights the importance of knowing the law inside and out so that your work is solid in court. You'll also learn practical ways to handle arrests, searches, and other challenges without getting tripped up by technicalities.

Duty to Intervene (Instructed by: Zach Miller)

Being ready to step in when things go wrong is a key part of building trust—both within the department and in the community. This course gives officers the skills and knowledge they need to recognize when intervention is necessary and to act confidently and safely. You'll learn about the legal requirements and department policies that spell out the duty to intervene, and why it matters. The course also covers the serious consequences of failing to act, including discipline, lawsuits, and even criminal charges. Through real-life case studies and scenarios, you'll develop the confidence to do the right thing—while keeping yourself and your colleagues safe.
